



PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

UFootballSC is committed to creating a positive, safe, respectful, and enjoyable environment for all players. Parents and guardians play a vital role in supporting the development, confidence, and overall experience of every participant within the academy.

Respect and Sportsmanship

Parents and guardians are expected to demonstrate respect toward players, coaches, referees, volunteers, staff members, opponents, and spectators at all academy activities. Positive encouragement and good sportsmanship should be displayed at all times.

Abusive language, harassment, discrimination, intimidation, threats, or disrespectful conduct will not be tolerated.

Supporting Player Development

Parents are encouraged to focus on effort, learning, teamwork, discipline, personal growth, and enjoyment of the game rather than solely on results and competition outcomes.

Players should be given the opportunity to learn from both successes and mistakes in a positive and supportive environment.

Communication with Coaches and Staff

Questions, concerns, or feedback should be communicated respectfully through appropriate channels.

Parents should avoid approaching coaches, referees, or academy staff during games, training sessions, or immediately following events when emotions may be elevated.

Sideline Conduct

Parents are expected to maintain a positive atmosphere on the sidelines and refrain from coaching players during training sessions or matches.

Technical instruction and game-related decisions should remain the responsibility of academy coaches.

Player Safety and Well-Being

Parents must ensure that players arrive on time, properly equipped, and prepared for participation.

Medical conditions, injuries, allergies, or other health concerns that may affect participation should be communicated to the academy promptly.

Parents are expected to support all academy safety policies and procedures.

Respect for Facilities and Property

Parents and players must respect all facilities, fields, equipment, and property used during academy programs and events.

Any intentional damage or misconduct may result in disciplinary action.

Photography and Social Media

Parents should respect the privacy and dignity of all participants when sharing photographs, videos, or academy-related content online.

Content that may be harmful, offensive, inappropriate, or disrespectful toward players, coaches, referees, or other families is not permitted.
